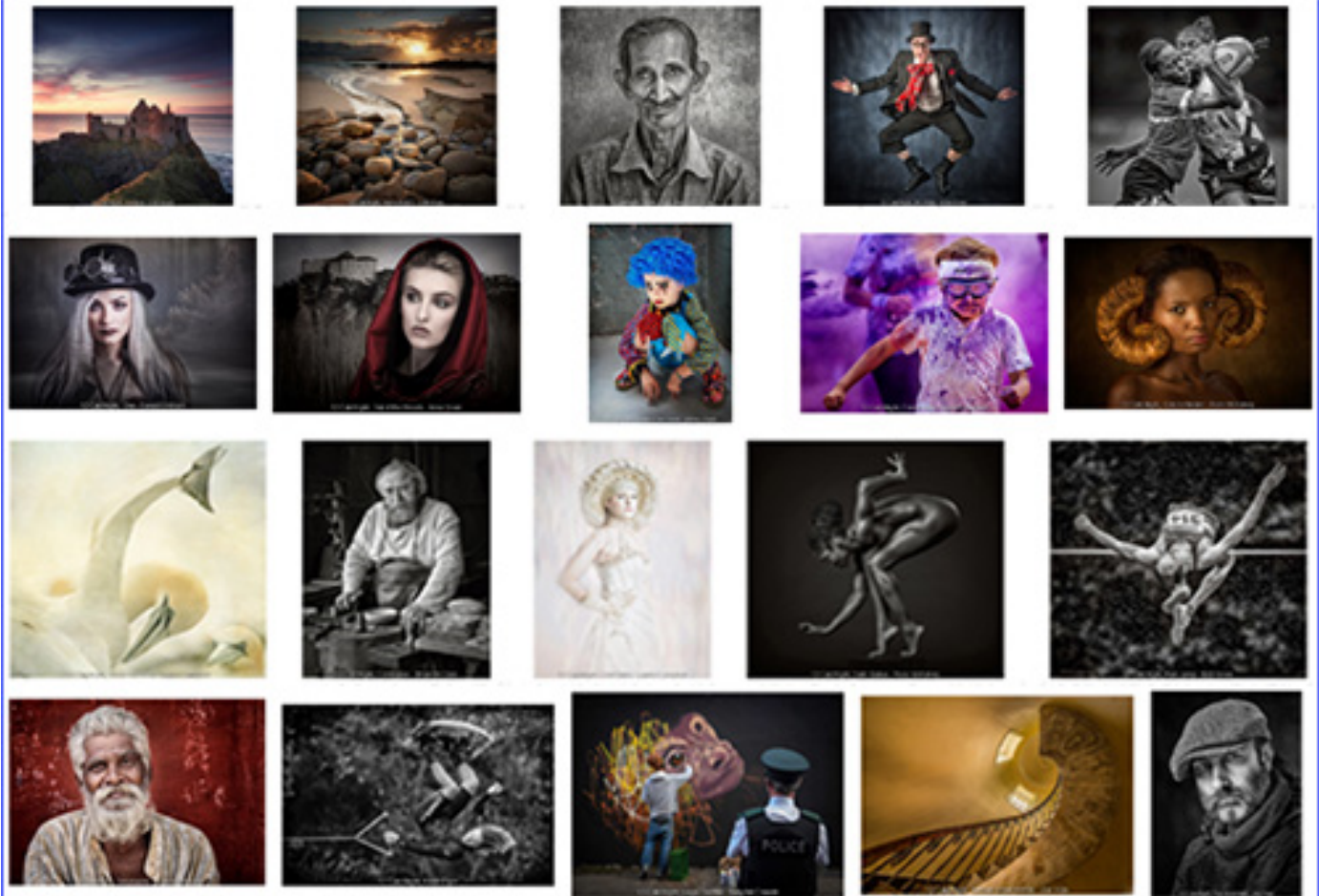

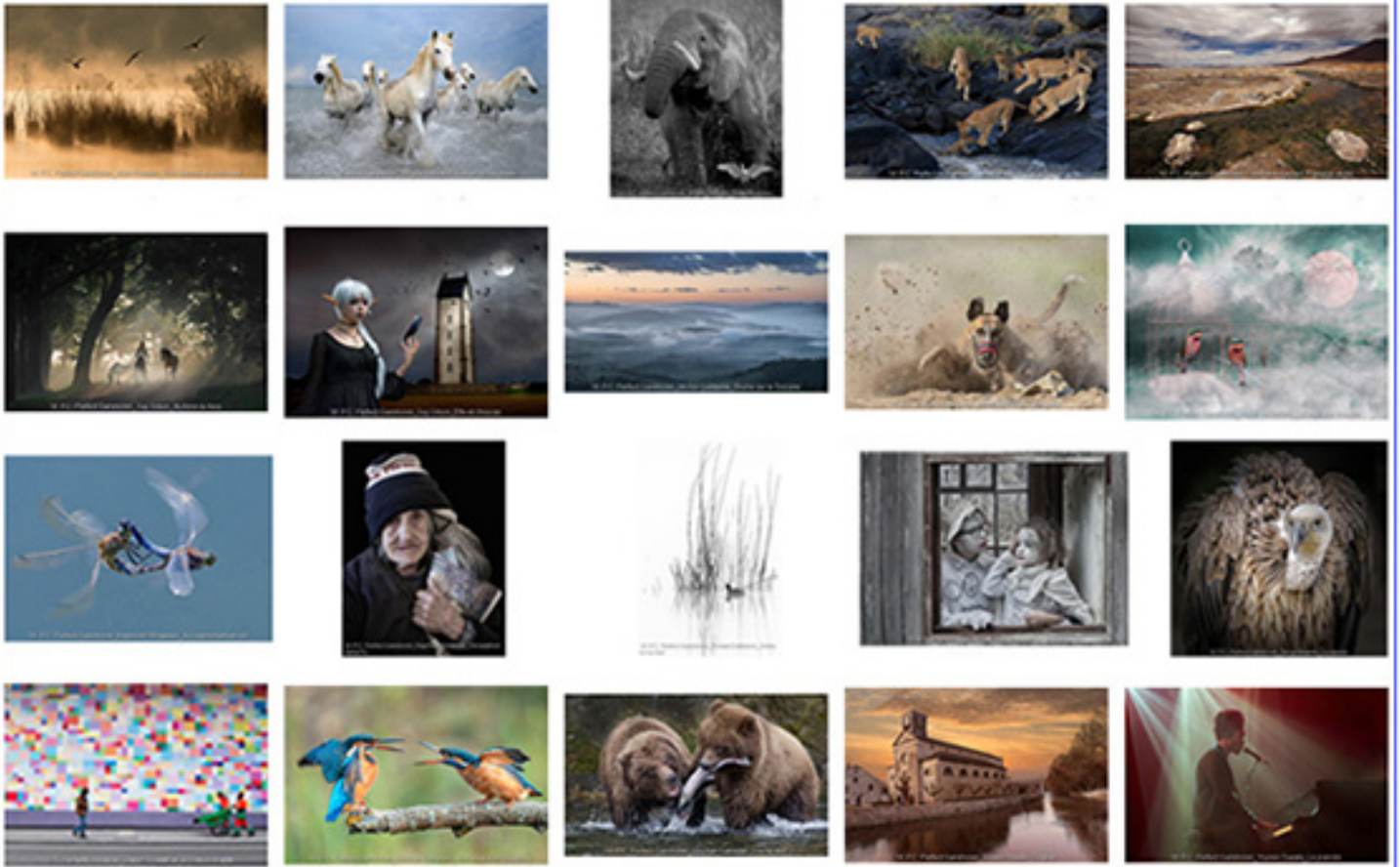
## 11<sup>th</sup> FIAP CLUB WORLD CUP – ACCEPTANCE SCORE

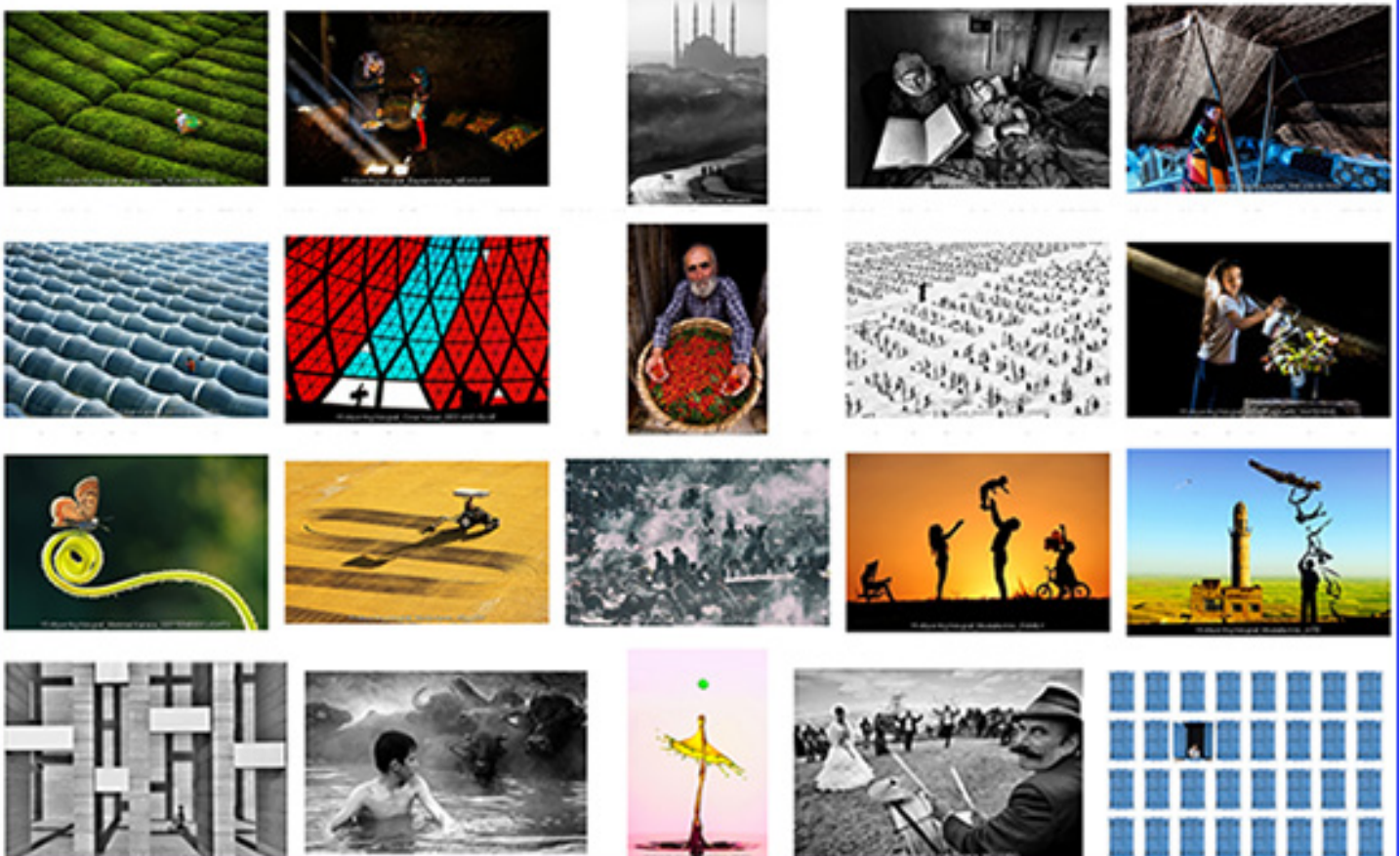

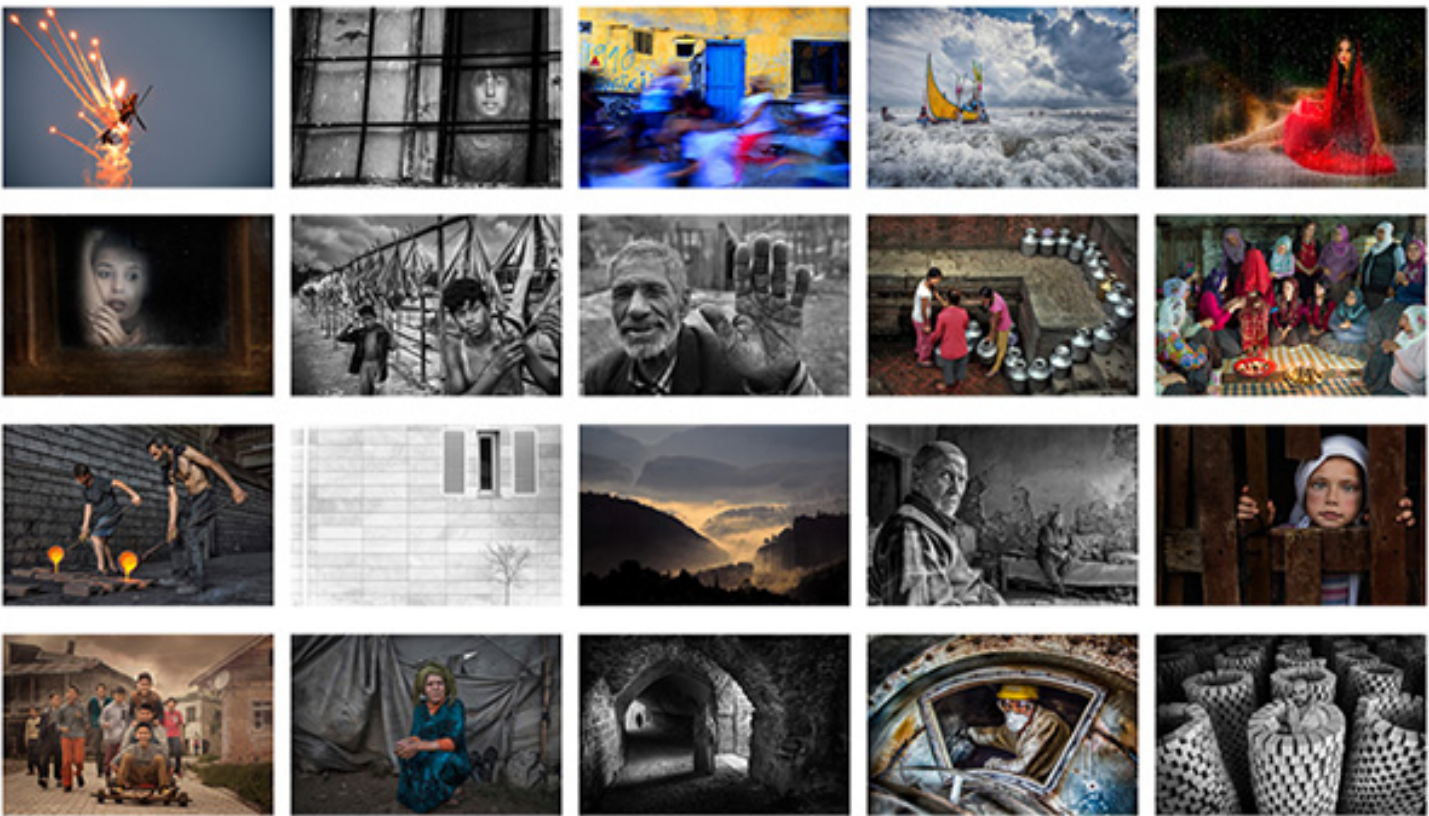

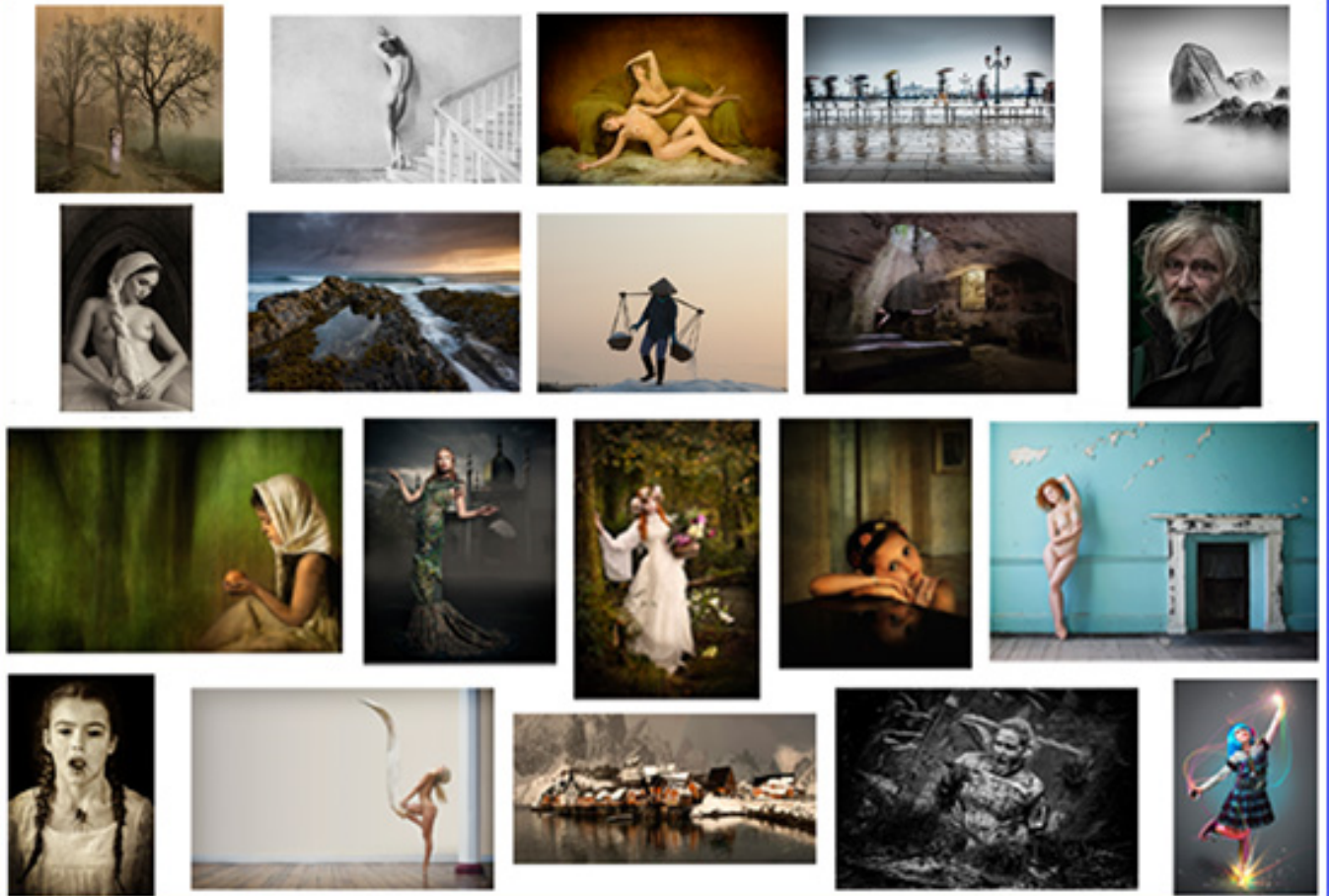
