The judging of the PAGB GB Trophy was completed on 22nd January and the GB Cup judging was started on 23rd January and concluded on 25th January.

### **GB TROPHY**

This year there were 833 print submitted by 27 clubs to the two categories. For the second year running there was no charge for entering prints.

With the easing of Covid restrictions it was possible to conduct the judging face to face at the premises used by Huddersfield Photo-Imaging Club.

The PAGB judges were:

Erica Oram CPAGB AFIAP BPE3 Jane Lines MPAGB BPE5 Nick Hilton DPAGB EFIAP/b BPE5

Adrian Lines, and two members of the host club assisted with the handling of the prints and the IT set up was run by Adrian Lines.

The winning club in both categories was Rolls Royce Derby Photographic Society and Silver and Bronze Medals were awarded for images in both categories.

### GB CUP

This year there were 3449 PDIs submitted by 90 clubs to the two categories. With on-line judging of PDIs now well-established, the GB Cup was judged in this way using the system made possible by our in-house software developer, Adrian Lines.

The PAGB judges were:

The winning club in Open was Nottingham & Notts Photographic Society, whilst the winning club in Nature was Rolls Royce Derby Photographic Society following a tie over 12 images and a count back to 17 images.

Silver and Bronze Medals and Certificates were awarded in both categories.

### OVERALL AWARDS

The Gold Medal for the Club achieving the highest overall score (totalled from the Club's 12 highest scoring images in each category) across the whole Event went to: Rolls Royce Derby Photographic Society.

The Gold Medal for Nature Photographer of the Year based on the total score for Images by one Photographer went to Julia Wainwright MPAGB FRPS of Harrow C.C.

My thanks go to the clubs which entered, our sponsors Epson and Paper Spectrum, and all the judges and committee members who gave their time so generously to ensure a successful competitions. Congratulations to the winning clubs, our Nature Photographer of the Year and to all those receiving medals and certificates. Hope to see even more entries for the next GB Cup and GB Trophy.
