

Many had not entered many National or International competitions, thinking that their style of photography was not likely to be successful. Our judges were happy to be able to stretch the boundaries.

Your photograph will be exhibited all over the UK, including a prestigious London showing, a stone's throw from the South Bank and you will receive a superb, beautifully produced, catalogue with just one picture on every page. Yours could be one of them. Your Editor is happy to claim that this was the best catalogue produced last year for any amateur exhibition.

Even if you miss out on selection, you can become part of the Salon Refusés, which is hired by lots of Clubs to give a great evening's entertainment.

Making the Best of a Long, Hot Summer!

We hadn't planned to shoot under the hot summer sun but, when we came across this lovely cornfield bathed in late afternoon sunshine, it was too much to resist. Our pale costumes and straw hats had been inspired by the recent TV series *Picnic at Hanging Rock* but against the golden hues and rich textures of the corn they looked more like rural America in the 1900s.

In this edit I cloned some of the left-hand horizon in Photoshop to remove distracting details and to match the symmetry of the 4 models and used ColorEfex to mute the colour palette to suggest olden times.
