Why did your Club not enter this Limited GB Cup?

One of the Top Clubs is likely to win most GB Cup Competitions, so it is surprising that very few Clubs attempt the GB Cup Limited Eligibility where they have a much better chance of doing well, since ever Club which has won before or has qualified to compete in either Inter-Club Championship is barred from entering this competition. Perhaps it is the name and I believe that the Chairman is considering an alternative.

GB Trophy and GB Cup sponsored by Epson and Paper Spectrum

The GB Cup and GB Trophy were both held on the weekend of the 27th and 28th January at Smethwick's clubhouse in Oldbury. I must thank the team at Smethwick for allowing us to host this event in their clubhouse and the way that they looked after us.

The GB Cup Open had 1325 entries from 58 clubs and there were1325 entries in the GB Cup for Nature from 62 clubs. The GB Cup Limited Eligibility had 232 entries from 10 clubs.

The GB Trophy had a total of 848 prints in nature and open sections.

The Judges were kept very busy over the weekend and my thanks go to them for their perseverance. Special thanks to Libby Smith for running the competitions and for her invaluable help before, during and after the Judging.

My last thanks must go to all of those who entered, without whom there would not be a competition. Congratulations if you or your club received an award but, if not there is always next year.
