How to enter the MASTERS OF PRINT (MOP)

This event allows you to enter as an Individual or you can organise a collection on behalf of your Club. You should be a bona fide member of a Club affiliated to the PAGB and you may only enter for one Club each year. We are looking for "new" exciting work, not previously exhibited, and all genre and styles have an equal chance of success.

Entries, either by an Individual or by a Club, must be made through the PAGB on-line Entries System. This includes PDI copies of your prints 2400 pixels on the longest side.

The system provides a download of labels, with barcodes, which must be fixed to the back of each Print. When viewed from the back, the label should be placed as close as possible to the top right corner. In addition to the Print labels, the system provides a download of documentation to be sent to the Organisers with the Prints.

We will happily accept your prints for the Eighth MASTERS OF PRINT at the Inter-Club Print Championship in Blackburn or at the Awards for Photographic Merit Adjudication in November, or indeed, at any PAGB event

You enter via the PAGB CES Website which will require you to register as an Individual and/or as a Club if you are not already registered.

60 Prints are then selected for the Exhibition (max one per author), and awards are made to individual prints. In addition to this, every entrant will receives a copy of this year's superb "coffee table" photobook featuring all of the Accepted photographs, one per page.

Club Awards - Club Entrants and Individual Entrants will each accrue points towards their Club score for a chance to win two generous Club Awards, each with a handsome trophy provided by our primary sponsors, Online Paper and CEWE

CAMERA CLUB IMAGES ON THE INTERNET.

You may have seen in e-news 361 an article about image copyright. A member at Davyhulme Camera Club had entered into one of their competitions an image downloaded from the internet. Like most clubs Davyhulme publish successful images on their website. However, the picture library who owned the copyright found the image, contacted the club and threatened a fine of £500 for illegal use of the image. Fortunately, things were amicably sorted out.

So, apart from the copyright issue, which can easily be checked in Windows File Explorer, by adding the copyright field into the columns displayed by file manager, are your clubs' images being found and indexed by search engines and are you as a club OK with this?

- Can you easily find out if your club images are being found by Google? Yes
- Can you stop this happening? Y es
- Can you remove these images from Google Search? Yes
- The following refers to Google, as it is the most popular web search engine.

Search for your Images.

Using Google Image search, type in the search box site: your club's web address. e.g. site: ww.chelmsfordcameraclub.info This returns no images from our website, but some from Facebook, although degraded as to be of no use.

Stop your clubs' images being indexed.

Using a text editor create a file called robots.txt Add the following lines:

- User-agent: *
- Disallow: /images/
- User-agent: Googlebot-Image
- o Disallow: /

Lines 1&2 tells all search engines not to index the /images/ folder (You can have as many of these disallows as necessary). Lines 3&4 tells Googlebot-Image search not to index any images.

Publish this file to the root folder of your website i.e. where your index.html file is stored. There is plenty of info on the web about robots.txt, start here: https://tinyurl.com/nhet2meb

Remove Images from Google Image Search.

This is a bit more complicated and too much information to add here. You will need a Google Account to associate your website with, see https://developers.google.com/search From this page select Developer, Then select "Check if and how you're appearing on Search" Then on the left menu panel under "Crawling and Indexing" Select Removals

INTER-CLUB PRINT CHAMPIONSHIP

On behalf of the PAGB Inter-Club Print Championship Committee, we are looking forward to welcoming you to the Inter-Club Print Championship to be held at Westholme School, Blackburn, BB2 6QU on Saturday 19 October 2024.

We will now be using the Central Management System (CMS) for the competition. This has been frequently requested by entrants and, thanks to the work of Adrian Lines, we are able to use the CMS for the Championship. This requires some changes to the rules. Principally that the print bank for clubs can no longer be unlimited but will instead be restricted to a maximum of 50 Prints and clubs will need to upload the image titles and a PDI version of their Bank to the CMS, as is already the case for other PAGB competitions.

(Note: 50 Prints in the Club Bank is the maximum, not a requirement.)

The PAGB CMS will open for clubs to submit their round one entries in early September and will close about 10 days before the date of the competition. The exact dates will be notified on the CMS and in **e-news**. If you do not yet have a CMS Club account you will need to register one before you can enter your club's images.

Please note that, as in previous years, no tickets have been reserved for any clubs and must be purchased through the CMS. Tickets will be available shortly. We will be checking that those attending have purchased tickets so please don't turn up without obtaining a ticket.

Westholme School will, as in previous years, be providing catering facilities including coffee/tea and pastries on arrival, lunch and afternoon refreshments. Westholme School is a cash-free school and so credit/debit cards will be needed for the catering.

However you will cash to purchase raffle tickets. We have some excellent raffle prizes from our sponsors worth well over £2,000 which you will want to win!

There will also be a commercial exhibition with special offers on the day, including inkjet papers and mounts for your next set of winning images.

Tickets are now available through the PAGB CMS for the Inter-Club Print Championship. This is your chance to see prints from some of the leading clubs with a range of genres and outstanding print quality.






